On a motion by Senator D'Allesandro, seconded by Representative Weyler, that the Committee approve the request of the Administrative Office of The Courts to transfer \$492,000 in general and other funds between expenditure classes through June 30, 2017. MOTION ADOPTED.

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The Committee requested a list of all the assumptions or other variables that the Department can urge the actuaries to take into account when calculating per member-per monthly rates for Medicaid Managed Care.

<u>FIS 17-076 Department of Health and Human Services</u> – On a motion by Senator D'Allesandro, seconded by Representative Rosenwald, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Health and Human Services to transfer \$242,040 in general funds, and increase federal revenues in the amount of \$59,375 and increase other revenues in the amount of \$255,536 through June 30, 2017.
