CONSENT CALENDAR

FIS 19-092 Judicial Council – On a motion by Representative Ober, seconded by Senator Feltes, that the Committee approve the request of the Judicial Council to receive an additional appropriation from funds not otherwise appropriated in the amount of \$396,000 in general funds through June 30, 2019. MOTION ADOPTED.

<u>FIS 19-093 Judicial Council</u> – On a motion by Representative Ober, seconded by Senator Feltes, that the Committee approve the request of the Judicial Council to receive an additional appropriation from funds not otherwise appropriated in the amount of \$50,000 in general funds through June 30, 2019. MOTION ADOPTED.

On a motion by Representative Weyler, seconded by Representative Ober, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Corrections for additional funding in the amount of \$889,000 in general funds for medical payments to providers to cover projected shortfalls through June 30, 2019. <u>FIS 19-095 Department of Administrative Services</u> – Charles Arlinghaus, Commissioner, and Shelia Gagnon, Chief Financial Officer, Department of Administrative Services, presented the request and responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Representative Ober, seconded by Senator Feltes, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Administrative Services to transfer \$312,755 in general funds and create new class codes through June 30, 2019. MOTION ADOPTED.
