<u>FIS 19-114 Department of Health and Human Services</u> – Kerrin Rounds, Chief Financial Officer, Department of Health and Human Services responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Representative Ober, seconded by Senator Rosenwald, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Health and Human Services to transfer \$1,501,247 in general funds between various class lines, increase federal revenues in the amount of \$781,380, decrease related other revenues in the amount of \$8,438, and create new expenditure class codes through June 30, 2019. MOTION ADOPTED.

FIS 19-109 Department of Administrative Services – On a motion by Representative Ober, seconded by Representative Ford, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Administrative Services to reduce the Active Trooper Health Benefit Statutory Reserve from 100% of estimated annual claims and administrative expenses to 75% of estimated annual claims and administrative expenses thereby releasing \$913,000 to be made available for fluctuations in plan costs that occur on a monthly basis. FIS 19-100 New Hampshire Fish and Game Department – On a motion by Representative Ober, seconded by Senator Rosenwald, that the Committee approve the request of the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department to transfer \$900,000 of unexpended funds from Excess Registration Fees to the Fish and Game OHRV Fiscal Year 2019 Operating Budget through June 30, 2019. MOTION ADOPTED.

FIS 19-117 Department of Natural and Cultural Resources — On a motion by Representative Ober, seconded by Representative Ford, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources for approval of; 1) rate changes to the primary summer 2019 and winter 2019/20 products at Franconia Notch State Park and Cannon

Mountain Aerial Tramway and Ski Area, and 2) further approval of the 2019/20 Cannon Mountain Winter Special Use Policy. MOTION ADOPTED.
