FISCAL COMMITTEE OF THE GENERAL COURT **MINUTES**

June 26, 2015

The Fiscal Committee of the General Court met on Friday, June 26, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. in Room 210-211 of the Legislative Office Building.

Chairman Kurk opened the meeting at 10:03 a.m.

ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES:

On a motion by Senator Sanborn, seconded by Senator Little, that the minutes of the May 15, 2015 meeting be accepted as written. MOTION ADOPTED. (7-Yes, 2-Abstained)

NEW BUSINESS:

RSA 14:30-a, VI FISCAL COMMITTEE APPROVAL REQUIRED FOR ACCEPTANCE AND EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS OVER \$100,000 FROM ANY NON-STATE SOURCE:

CONSENT CALENDAR

Chairman Kurk announced that all items would be removed from the Consent Calendar and each item considered separately.

FIS 15-095 State Treasury - William Dwyer, State Treasurer, responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Representative Weyler, seconded by Representative Eaton, that the Committee approve the request of the State Treasury to accept and expend \$700,000. MOTION ADOPTED.

FIS 15-106 Department of Health and Human Services – Sheri Rockburn, Chief Financial Officer, Department of Health and Human Services responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Representative Eaton, seconded by Representative Ober, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Health and Human Services to accept and expend \$540,302. MOTION ADOPTED.

The Committee requested the Department provide an analysis of MET revenue distributions for 2014 and 2015 to the Fiscal Committee members.

FIS 15-107 Department of Safety – On a motion by Representative Eaton, seconded by Representative Ober, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Safety to amend FIS 15-055, approved April 3, 2015, by reallocating \$2,400 in federal funds through June 30, 2015. MOTION ADOPTED.

RSA 7:6-e DISPOSITION OF FUNDS OBTAINED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL:

FIS 15-098 Department of Justice – Ann Rice, Deputy Attorney General, and Kathleen Carr, Director of Administration, Department of Justice, responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Representative Eaton, seconded by Representative Ober, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Justice to budget and expend \$53,000.70 in settlement funds from multistate settlements and request to retain said funds for the support of the Department's Consumer/Antitrust Bureaus. No Action Taken.

On a motion by Senator Sanborn, seconded by Representative Weyler, that the Committee table the request of the Department of Justice to budget and expend \$53,000.70 in settlement funds from multistate settlements and request to retain said funds for the support of the Department's Consumer/Antitrust Bureaus. No Action Taken.

Vicki Quiram, Commissioner, Joseph Bouchard, Assistant Commissioner, and Gerard Murphy, State Comptroller, Department of Administrative Services were also present to respond to questions.

On a motion by Representative Eaton, seconded by Representative Ober, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Safety to budget and expend \$122,000 from the Prior Year Carry Forward Balance of the Enhanced E-911 System Fund through June 30, 2015. Action held to allow the State Comptroller to provide additional information.

FIS 15-100 New Hampshire Fish and Game Department – On a motion by Representative Eaton, seconded by Representative Ober, that the Committee approve the request of the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department to transfer \$125,000 of unexpended funds from Excess Registration Fees to the Fish and Game OHRV Fiscal Year 2015 Operating Budget. MOTION ADOPTED.

<u>FIS 15-096 Department of Health and Human Services</u> – On a motion by Representative Eaton, seconded by Representative Ober, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Health and Human Services to transfer \$140,467 in general funds, with no net change to federal revenues, through June 30, 2015. MOTION ADOPTED.

<u>FIS 15-097 Department of Health and Human Services</u> — On a motion by Representative Eaton, seconded by Representative Ober, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Health and Human Services to transfer \$532,643 in general funds, increase related federal revenues in the amount of \$2,502,642, and increase related other revenues in the amount of \$1,141 through June 30, 2015. MOTION ADOPTED.

<u>FIS 15-103 Department of Transportation</u> – On a motion by Representative Eaton, seconded by Representative Ober, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Transportation to transfer \$28,500 between various accounts and classes through June 30, 2015. MOTION ADOPTED.

<u>FIS 15-104 Department of Transportation</u> – On a motion by Representative Eaton, seconded by Representative Ober, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Transportation to transfer \$13,500 within Turnpike Fund accounting units and classes through June 30, 2015. MOTION ADOPTED.
