The Department of Agriculture, Markets, and Food proposes to adopt Chapter Agr 4100, which establishes administrative rules for the animal records database in accordance with RSA 437:8-a and RSA 437:8-b. The proposal recognizes the change to official certificates of transfer created by veterinarians electronically with provisions for a waiver and replacing official health certificates as was intended in RSA 437:8-a and RSA 437:8-b which were adopted by 2021, 91:302, effective June 25, 2021. The rule implements RSA 437:8-a and RSA 437:8-b for the first time.

Pet owners, New Hampshire licensed veterinarians, pet vendors, and the general public are affected by this rule.
