After speaking with Rep. Bergeron, I understand that you would like the detail with respect to our population densities across each ward. I have attached the report detailing our analysis of each ward and the effect of the proposed redistricting adjustments that was submitted along with the actual boundary adjustments which ultimately went to our public hearing.

These population numbers remain accurate with the exception of wards 2 and 6. After the comment period during the public hearing, the board made a slight adjustment to ward 6 by moving 20 residents back to ward 2 by readjusting the Wellington Road boundary line between the two wards back (see East side of map on page 9 of 10 within the report) to the pre-redistricting boundary line.

In effect, this changes the ward population table below (Excerpted from page 4 of the attached report) for a total population in ward 2 of 9,677 and ward 6 of 9,583. All other totals remain accurate.
