Republicans Stand Up for N.H. Students

Concord, NH – Senator Ruth Ward (R-Stoddard) released the following statement on the passage of Senate Bill 136, prohibiting the employment or volunteering of a revoked or suspended educator:

“The safety and well-being of our children must remain a priority - Senate Bill 136 strengthens standards regarding who can work with our vulnerable students,” stated Senator Ward.

“When a serious enough offense occurs that results in the suspension or total revocation of an educator’s license, that individual cannot be trusted to continue working in another position within that same institution. SB 136 is common sense, and it’s a win for students in the Granite State.
