

Amendment to HB 130

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

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3 AN ACT relative to the prescription drug affordability board.

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5 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

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7 1 Prescription Drug Affordability Board; Funding; Fees Removed RSA 126-BB:8 is repealed and
8 reenacted to read as follows:

9 126-BB:8 Funding; General Funds and Voluntary Contributions.

10 I. The expenses and cost of operation of the board shall be funded by general funds or by
11 voluntary contributions to the board's dedicated fund.

12 II. There is established a nonlapsing fund to be known as the New Hampshire prescription
13 drug affordability board administration fund, which shall be kept distinct and separate from all
14 other funds. The fund shall be continually appropriated to and administered by the board.
15 Voluntary contributions under this section shall be deposited in the fund. The board shall use the
16 fund, consistent with the provisions of this chapter, to receive funds and to reimburse costs incurred
17 by the board. The fund may be used to pay administrative, technical, legal support, or other costs
18 incurred by the board under this chapter. The state treasurer may invest moneys in the fund as
19 provided by law, and all interest received on such investment shall be credited to the fund. The
20 dedicated fund shall be subject to the provisions of RSA 6:12-j.

21 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
