## RSA 4:39-b APPROVAL OF STATE AGENCY LEASES EXCEEDING 5 YEARS:

<u>LRCP 22-019 Department of Administrative Services</u> – Charles Arlinghaus, Commissioner, and Jared Nylund, Real Property Manager, Department of Administrative Services presented the request and responded to questions of the Committee.

On a motion by Representative Milz, seconded by Senator D'Allesandro, that the Committee approve the request of the Department of Administrative Services to enter into a twenty-year lease agreement with 81 Hall Street, LLC for approximately 106,400 square feet of usable office space consisting of the entire South Building portion of a certain office building located at 1 Granite Place, Concord, NH together with the land underlying said South Building and related parking areas and driveways at a fixed annual base rent of \$1,179,400.00, payable in equal monthly installments, effective for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2042, subject to the conditions as specified in the request dated June 21, 2022.
