Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

New Section; Public Utilities Commission; Rates and Charges; Proceedings. Amend RSA 378
by inserting after section 2 the following new section:

3 378:2-a Proceedings of the Commission. Every proceeding conducted by the commission to 4 determine the rates and charges of a public utility, whether conducted pursuant to this chapter or 5 otherwise, shall be considered a contested case within the meaning of RSA 541-A:1, IV and shall be 6 resolved by the commission after notice and an opportunity for hearing pursuant to the contested 7 case provisions of RSA 541-A:31-36.

8 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2022.
