Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 218:1 Uniform Anatomical Gift Act; Honoring an Individual's Decision to Donate. Amend RSA 2 291-A:23 to read as follows: 3 291-A:23 Honoring an Individual's Decision to Donate. A person's decision to make a donation 4 of that person's own body, organ, or tissue after death shall be honored and may not be revoked or amended by anyone after such individual's death. In the absence of a revocation or 5 6 amendment by the individual prior to death, health care providers and procurement 7 organizations shall act in accordance with the donor's decision and may take appropriate actions to 8 effect the anatomical gift.

218:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
