This bill prohibits political advertising that states or suggests a candidate for office would have opposed legislation from prior legislative sessions when the candidate in question has either never been a legislator or was not a legislator when such legislation was voted on.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 New Section; Certain Political Advertising Prohibited. Amend RSA 664 by inserting after section 17-a the following new section:
  3 664:17-b Political Advertising; Prohibitions. No political advertisement shall explicitly state or suggest that a candidate for office would have opposed legislation from prior legislative sessions when the candidate in question has either never been a legislator or was not a legislator when such legislation was voted on.
  - 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
