Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1	1 Absentee Ballot Application Form. Amend RSA 657:4, I to read as follows:
2	I. Prior to any state election, the secretary of state shall prepare the appropriate application
3	forms for absentee ballots worded in substantially the following form. The secretary of state shall
4	insert the names of all parties qualified as set forth in RSA 652:11 in the list of parties on the
5	application form. The secretary of state shall prepare the application forms in such quantity as he or
6	she deems necessary:
7	Absence (Excluding Absence Due to Residence Outside the United States), Religious Observance,
8	and Disability:
9	I hereby declare that (check one):
10	I am a duly qualified voter who is currently registered to vote in this town/ward.
11	I am absent from the town/city where I am domiciled and will be until after the next
12	election, or I am unable to register in person due to a disability, and request that the forms
13	necessary for absentee voter registration be sent to me with the absentee ballot.
14	I will be entitled to vote by absentee ballot because (check one):
15	I plan to be absent on the day of the election from the city, town, or unincorporated place
16	where I am domiciled.
17	I am requesting a ballot for the presidential primary election and I may be absent on the
18	day of the election from the city, town, or unincorporated place where I am domiciled, but the date of
19	the election has not been announced. I understand that I may only make such a request 14 days
20	after the filing period for candidates has closed, and that if I will not be absent on the date of the
21	election I am not eligible to vote by absentee ballot.
22	I cannot appear in public on election day because of observance of a religious commitment.
23	I am unable to vote in person due to a disability.
24	I cannot appear at any time during polling hours at my polling place because of an
25	employment obligation. For the purposes of this application, the term "employment shall include the
26	care of children and infirm adults, with or without compensation.
27	For use only on the Monday immediately prior to the election: I cannot appear at my polling
28	place on election day because the National Weather Service has issued a winter storm warning,
29	blizzard warning, or ice storm warning for election day applicable to my city, town, or

I am elderly or infirm or I have a physical disability, and would otherwise vote in person
but I have concerns for my safety traveling in the storm.
I anticipate that school, child care, or adult care will be canceled, and would otherwise
vote in person but will need to care for children or infirm adults.
Any person who votes or attempts to vote using an absentee ballot who is not entitled to vote by
absentee ballot shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. RSA 657:24.

15	The applicant must sign this form to receive an absentee ballot. Any person who witnesses and
16	assists a voter with a disability in executing this form shall print and sign his or her name in the
17	space provided on the application form. The moderator will not compare the voter's signature on the
18	application with the signature on the absentee ballot affidavit when a person assisting the voter has
19	signed the statement on the absentee ballot application or affidavit envelope that assistance was
20	provided.
21	2 New Section; Absentee Ballot Application Procedure; Identity Information. Amend RSA 657
22	by inserting after section 6 the following new section:
23	657:6-a Absentee Ballot Application Procedure; Identity Information. Identity information
24	sufficient to satisfy the requirements of RSA 657:4, I shall include a driver's license number and
25	state of issuance, a nondriver's picture identification card number and state of issuance, the last 4
26	digits of a social security number, or any other information or records that the town clerk may verify.
27	The town clerk is authorized to verify driver's license and nondriver's picture identification card
28	information, when provided, with the department of safety, division of motor vehicles or local law
29	enforcement. The statewide centralized voter registration database shall be reviewed and updated
30	based on any information provided with the absentee ballot application.

3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
