Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

New Section; Designated Open Container Area. Amend RSA 178 by inserting after section 27 a the following new section:
178:27-b Designated Open Container Area. A municipality may establish an outdoor area on
municipally-owned property where containers of alcoholic beverages that have been purchased
legally may be opened and consumed.
2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
