Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 State of Emergency Declaration; Evacuations. Amend RSA 4:45, III(c) to read as follows:
  2 (c) To provide for and [eompel] recommend the evacuation of all or part of the
  3 population from any stricken or threatened area or areas within the state and to take such steps as
  4 are necessary for the receipt and care of such evacuees; provided that emergency services shall
  5 not be required for those who have chosen not to evacuate.
  - 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
