SB 41 - AS INTRODUCED

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT relative to police disciplinary hearings.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Police Standards and Training Council; Powers. Amend RSA 106-L:5, III to read as follows: $\mathbf{2}$ III. For the purposes of a disciplinary hearing, subpoena and examine witnesses under oath, 3 take oaths or affirmations, and reduce to writing testimony given at any hearing[. Any] provided 4that any person whose rights or privileges may be affected at such a disciplinary hearing may appear with witnesses and be represented by counsel, and further provided that any $\mathbf{5}$ disciplinary hearing shall be public, but a party may petition to close a portion of the 6 7hearing to the public if the party seeking closure proves that such portion of the hearing 8 would disclose confidential information and that the disclosure creates a compelling 9 interest outweighing the public right of access.

10 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
