AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill repeals the prohibition against displaying a dead human body for longer than 24 hours unless such body is properly embalmed. The bill also provides that if final disposition of the body has not occurred with 48 hours after the funeral home obtains physical custody, the body must be embalmed, maintained at a temperature under 40 degrees Fahrenheit, or encased in a closed container.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Two*

AN ACT                    relative to public exposure of deceased human bodies.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1            192:1 New Section; Embalmers and Funeral Directors; Deceased Human Bodies. Amend RSA 325  
2 by inserting after section 40-a the following new section:

3            325:40-b Care of Deceased Human Bodies. If final disposition has not occurred within 48 hours after  
4 the funeral home obtains actual physical custody of the body, the body shall be embalmed or maintained  
5 at a temperature of under 40 degrees Fahrenheit or encased in a closed container with methods  
6 employed to prevent leakage.

7            192:2 Repeal. RSA 325:40-a, relative to the display of deceased human bodies for longer than 24  
8 hours, is repealed.

192:3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
