STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Two*

AN ACT                    requiring public schools to teach labor history.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1            1 New Section; Schools. Amend RSA 189 by inserting after section 11-d the following new  
2 section:

3            189:11-e United States and New Hampshire Labor History. Each public school in the state, as  
4 part of the school board-approved middle/high school education program, shall provide instruction as  
5 part of the standard history curriculum under RSA 189:11 on United States and New Hampshire  
6 labor history including notable strikes, unionization drives, and other labor actions.

7            2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
