1 92:1 New Paragraph; Criminal Code; Sentences and Limitations. Amend RSA 651:2 by inserting 2 after paragraph II-g the following new paragraph: 3 II-h. A person charged with any offense under RSA 265, RSA 265-A, or RSA 630:3 whose 4 offense was also based on facts involving the prohibited use of a mobile electronic device while driving, as 5 defined in RSA 265:79-c, may be subject to enhanced penalties for such offenses, as follows: 6 (a) If the offense would otherwise constitute a violation, it may be charged as a class B 7 misdemeanor. 8 (b) If the offense would otherwise constitute a class B misdemeanor, it may be charged as a 9 class A misdemeanor. 10 (c) If the offense would otherwise constitute a class A misdemeanor, it may be charged as a 11 class B felony. 12 (d) If the offense would otherwise constitute a class B felony, it may be charged as a class A 13 felony. 14 (e) If the offense is a class A felony or an unclassified felony, there shall be no enhanced 15 charge. 16 92:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2023.
