Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 New Paragraph; Ambient Groundwater Quality Standards; Per and Polyfluoroalkyl 2 Chemicals. Amend RSA 485-C:6 by inserting after paragraph VI the following new paragraph: 3 VII. By January 1, 2023, the commissioner shall, in consultation with the commissioner of 4 the department of health and human services and interested parties, initiate rulemaking to adopt
- 5 ambient groundwater quality standards for perfluorobutanoic acid (PFBA), perfluoroheptanoic acid 6
- (PFHpA); and perfluorodecanoic acid (PFDA).
  - 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
