HOUSE BILL 280

AN ACT relative to termination of an emergency order issued by the governor.

ANALYSIS

This bill provides that the legislature may terminate an emergency order, or any part of an emergency order, by concurrent resolution, adopted by a majority of vote of each chamber.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 New Subparagraph; State of Emergency Declaration; Termination by the Legislature. Amend
2 RSA 4:45, II by inserting after subparagraph (c) the following new subparagraph:
3 (d) The legislature may terminate any emergency order, or any part of an emergency
4 order, in the same manner as provided for terminating a state of emergency under subparagraph (c).
5 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
