

Amendment to SB 106

1 Amend the bill by replacing Part II with the following:

Establishing a committee to study adopting changes to the state fire and building codes.

1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study adopting changes to the state fire code and building code.

2 Membership and Compensation.

9

I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

(a) Three members of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

11

(b) Three members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the

12

house of representatives.

13

II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to

14

the duties of the committee.

15

3 Duties. The committee shall study adopting changes to the state fire code and building code.

16

The committee shall review and make recommendations for establishing a process for the adoption of new editions of national or model codes and any necessary amendments. This review shall include consideration of establishing a permanent statutory committee for this purpose.

4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from

among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named senate

21

member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this

22

section. Four members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed

24

legislation to the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, the senate

25

clerk, the house clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2021.

6 Effective Date. Part II of this act shall take effect upon its passage.
