1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

6 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

8 1 New Section; Analysis of Requests for Absentee Ballot Information. Amend RSA 657 by
9 inserting after section 24 the following new section:

10 657:24-a Analysis of Requests for Absentee Ballot Information. The attorney general shall
11 analyze the requests for absentee ballot information for state general elections and presidential
12 primary elections contained in the statewide centralized voter registration database for evidence of
13 misuse. The analysis shall include, but shall not be limited to, the number of absentee ballots
14 mailed to a common address and significant differences in the number of ballots that were requested
15 from a city or town. The results of the analysis and any additional actions identified shall be
16 reported to the house and senate committees with jurisdiction over elections within 120 days of the
17 election.

18 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
