The appropriations for those projects which are managed by the division of public works design and construction, department of administrative services, may be expended to fund temporary personnel for the purpose of providing construction inspection services and Davis-Bacon Act compliance services for projects utilizing federal funds, for those projects included in this act.
- II. The department of administrative services shall provide quarterly reports to the capital budget overview committee detailing the project status for all capital projects, including information technology projects, funded by the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) that have been approved by the fiscal committee of the general court. The first quarterly report shall be for the
