5 Recommendation:

6 That the House recede from its position of nonconcurrence with the Senate amendment, and
7 concur with the Senate amendment, and

8 That the Senate and House adopt the following new amendment to the bill as amended by the
9 Senate, and pass the bill as so amended:

11 Amend the bill by replacing section 1 with the following:

13 1 Absentee Ballot Lists; Electronic Copies. Amend RSA 657:15, II to read as follows:

14 II. Candidates whose names appear on the ballot and persons bearing notarized requests or
15 copies of notarized requests from candidates whose names appear on the ballot may obtain a list of
16 absentee voter applicants from the clerk, excluding voters who have presented to the supervisors of
17 the checklist valid protective orders pursuant to RSA 173-B. ***If requested this list shall be
18 supplied electronically from the information in the statewide centralized voter registration
19 database. If an electronic copy exists, it shall be provided without charge in accordance
20 with RSA 91-A.***
