AN ACT repealing a department of education report on chartered public school funding.

ANALYSIS

This bill removes the requirement that the commissioner of the department of education submit a report to the fiscal committee of the general court for each payment made in a fiscal year by the state to a chartered public school.

- 1 1 Repeal. RSA 194-B:11, I(e), relative to chartered public schools funding; report to the fiscal 2 committee, is repealed.
- 3 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
