9 Amend RSA 485:17-a, II(c) as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

11 (c) Water from other outlets available to children, including classroom and bathroom  
12 sinks and water outlets used for food preparation, shall be tested and remediated if necessary, per  
13 the provisions in paragraph III.
