REQUESTED ACTION

- Pursuant to RSA 14:30-a, VI, authorize the New Hampshire Fish and Game Department (NHFGD), to accept
 and expend \$161,939 of American Rescue Plan (ARP) State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (FRF) from the
 Department of Environmental Services (DES), for the purpose of hiring a short term temporary full time
 staff member to provide assistance in Alteration of Terrain (AOT) permit application review, effective upon
 Fiscal Committee and Governor and Council approval for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2023.
 Funding Source: 100% Federal Fund Transfer from Other Agency.
- Pursuant to the provision of RSA 124:15, I, Positions Restricted, and subject to approval of item 1
 above, authorize NHFGD to establish one, full-time temporary position using ARP FRF in support of
 the AOT permit application review process, effective upon Fiscal Committee and Governor and
 Council approval for the period July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2023. 100% Federal Fund Transfer
 from Other Agency.

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EXPLANATION

Pursuant to US Treasury 31 CFR Part 35, RIN 1505-AC77, the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established under the American Rescue Plan Act includes New Hampshire State funding for Water and Sewer Infrastructure Projects. Part of the process for Water and Sewer Infrastructure Projects requires review of alteration of terrain permit applications submitted to the DES by NHFGD for impact on protected wildlife. DES has requested administrative funds to support the increased administrative load this will create for NHFGD.

NHFGD will use these funds to hire a temporary full time staff member to help ensure timely performance of consultations and review of permit applications for protected wildlife by NHFGD for Water and Sewer Infrastructure Projects.

Funds are budgeted as follows:

Class 020 - Current Expenses - office supplies, paper and printer ink for staff

Class 030 - Equipment - Office equipment for staff

Class 039 - Telecommunications - phones and phone lines for staff

Class 059 - Temp Full Time - for one temporary full-time position requested above

Class 060 - Benefits - for the one temporary full-time position requested above

Class 070 - In State Travel Reimbursement - mileage incurred for work related activities
