SENATE BILL ***152-FN***

AN ACT relative to participation in state employees' group insurance by members of the general court.

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AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill allows the department of administrative services to invoice and collect payment for participation in the group insurance plan by members of the general court.

AN ACT                   relative to participation in state employees' group insurance by members of the

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1           80:1 New Paragraphs; Members of the General Court; Insurance Participation. Amend RSA 14-  
2 A:6 by inserting after paragraph II the following new paragraphs:

3           III. The commissioner of the department of administrative services shall invoice and collect  
4 amounts due from members. Collected amounts shall be deposited in the employee and retiree  
5 benefit risk management fund.

6           IV. Failure to remit payment for participation pursuant to paragraph I of this section in full  
7 within 30 days of billing shall be grounds for terminating benefits, effective with the beginning of the  
8 billing period. Reenrollment shall be dependent upon payment of outstanding participation or other  
9 amounts.

10          V. Failure to remit payment in full for participation pursuant to paragraph II of this section  
11 within 60 days of billing shall be grounds for permanently terminating benefits effective upon the  
12 beginning of the billing period. Either in the billing notice or in a separate notice to the person  
13 billed, the department of administrative services shall advise that failure to pay the specified  
14 amount in full within the required time shall be grounds for permanent termination of benefits.

15          80:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
