AN ACT relative to the procedure for approval of medical parole.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 134:1 Medical Parole. Amend RSA 651-A:10-a, III to read as follows:
- 2 III. Medical parole shall only be granted by a majority vote [of the full 7 member parole
- 3 board] which includes at least 3 votes of the members who are present and voting.
- 4 134:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
- 5 Approved: June 5, 2012
- 6 Effective Date: August 4, 2012
