AN ACT naming a bridge in Woodstock, New Hampshire the Hilliard Family Bridge.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 19:1 Bridge Named the Hilliard Family Bridge. Pursuant to RSA 4:43, the bridge crossing the
2 Pemigewasset River in the town of Woodstock, New Hampshire, being designated as bridge number
3 197/085 in the state bridge inventory shall be named the Hilliard Family Bridge. Appropriate
4 signage or markers may be placed at the site.

5 19:2 Signage. The cost of design, construction, maintenance, and installation of any signage,
6 replacement signage, or other markers authorized under section 1 of this act shall not be a charge to
7 the state. However, the design, construction, and installation of any signage or other markers
8 authorized under this act shall be approved by the department of transportation.

9 19:3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
