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ANALYSIS

This bill repeals a provision of the school accountability statute which allows a school to fulfill the adequate education accountability requirements by demonstrating full accreditation from the New England Association of Schools and Colleges.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

- 1           1 Repeal. RSA 193-E:3-b, I(c), relative to allowing a school to fulfill the adequate education
- 2           accountability requirements by demonstrating full accreditation from the New England Association
- 3           of Schools and Colleges, is repealed.
- 4           2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
