Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Number Plate Checks by Law Enforcement; Vehicles Parked at Hospitals. Amend $\mathbf{2}$ RSA 261:75-a to read as follows: 3 261:75-a Number Plate Checks by Law Enforcement. A duly sworn state, county, or local law enforcement officer in the performance of his or her duties may obtain, through electronic query from 4 $\mathbf{5}$ the department of safety, the registration information on a particular number plate and plate type or 6 number plate validation decal for any official purpose, whether the inquiry relates to a particular 7offense or is for general crime detection and prevention purposes, provided a record is kept regarding 8 such inquiry. The information so obtained shall only be used for valid law enforcement purposes and 9 shall not be disclosed to any unauthorized person for any purpose. The commissioner of safety may further limit the release of such information at his or her discretion. Upon request, a law 10 enforcement officer may disclose to hospital security personnel, by a return telephone call 11 12to a security office or in person to a uniformed security officer, the name of the registered owner of a vehicle parked on hospital property, and such disclosure shall be an official 1314and valid law enforcement purpose and such personnel shall be authorized persons for purposes of this section. 15162 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
