AN ACT                   relative to training for new executive branch commissioners.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1           1 New Section; New Commissioners' Orientation. Amend RSA 4 by inserting after section 5 the  
2 following new section:

3           4:5-a New Commissioners' Orientation. The office of the governor shall provide orientation and  
4 training materials to each new executive branch commissioner. The training shall include, but not  
5 be limited to, a review of relevant statutes and administrative rules, a summary of the  
6 administrative rulemaking process, budgetary responsibilities, the role of the fiscal committee, and  
7 an overview of the commissioners' work with the governor and executive council and the legislature.

8           2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
