AN ACT relative to registration of vehicles by residents without a permanent street address.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1 137:1 Registration by Residents Without a Permanent Street Address. Amend the section  
2 heading of RSA 261:52-c and RSA 261:52-c, I to read as follows:

3 261:52-c **Registration or** Re-Registration by Residents Without a Permanent Street Address.

4 I. A resident who is homeless without a permanent street address at the time of  
5 **registration or** re-registration may register a vehicle by certifying to the department in writing that  
6 he or she is currently resident in the town **or city** and by providing a letter signed by an authorized  
7 representative of a social service organization or agency qualified under section 501(c)(3) of the  
8 Internal Revenue Code stating that the person is authorized to use the mailing address of the  
9 organization or agency for purposes of contact by the department.

10 137:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
