AN ACT relative to town boundary perambulation.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Perambulation of Town Boundaries. Amend RSA 51:4 to read as follows:

2 51:4 Return. A return of the perambulation shall be made, particularly describing the courses

3 and distances and the marks and monuments of such line which shall be signed by the selectmen or

4 persons making the same, recorded in the respective town books, and filed with the secretary of

5 state. The selectmen or persons making the perambulation may use the coordinates

6 obtained using a recreational GPS devise to mark the town boundaries.

7 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
