STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Thirteen*

AN ACT                   relative to town boundary perambulation.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

- 1           1 Perambulation of Town Boundaries. Amend RSA 51:4 to read as follows:
- 2           51:4 Return. A return of the perambulation shall be made, particularly describing the courses
- 3           and distances and the marks and monuments of such line which shall be signed by the selectmen or
- 4           persons making the same, recorded in the respective town books, and filed with the secretary of
- 5           state. ***The selectmen or persons making the perambulation may use the coordinates***
- 6           ***obtained using a recreational GPS devise to mark the town boundaries.***
- 7           2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
