AN ACT                   relative to school district policies on health and sex education.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

- 1           1 School Boards; Health and Sex Education. Amend RSA 186:11, IX-b to read as follows:  
2           IX-b. Health and Sex Education. Require school districts to adopt a policy allowing an  
3 exception to a particular unit of health or sex education instruction based on religious objections ***or***  
4 ***moral beliefs***. Such policy shall include a provision for alternative learning sufficient to enable the  
5 child to meet state requirements for health education.  
6           2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
