STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT relative to access to school-approved means of communication by recognized youth organizations.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Subdivision; Access by Recognized Youth Organizations. Amend RSA 189 by inserting 2 after section 64 the following new subdivision: 3 Access by Recognized Youth Organizations 4 189:65 Access to Public School Facilities by Recognized Youth Organizations. A school district shall allow a patriotic organization as defined in 36 U.S.C. sec. 201 et. seq., to have reasonable access 5 6 to, and use of, school-approved means of communication for the purpose of advertising activities, and 7 to distribute literature for recruitment or other purposes, provided that such literature may be 8 distributed at not more than 2 school-sponsored events per school year. All costs associated with 9 such communication shall be borne by the patriotic organization.

2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
