STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Thirteen

AN ACT establishing a committee to study the construction of a permanent memorial to Governor John Gilbert Winant on state property other than the state house grounds.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 120:1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study the construction of a
2 permanent memorial to Governor John Gilbert Winant on state property other than the state house
3 grounds.

4 120:2 Membership and Compensation.

5 I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

6 (a) Three members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the
7 house of representatives.

8 (b) One member of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

9 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to
10 the duties of the committee.

11 120:3 Duties. The committee shall study the construction of a permanent memorial to Governor
12 John Gilbert Winant on state property other than the state house grounds, including an appropriate
13 site, design, and private funding source.

14 120:4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson
15 from among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named
16 house member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 30 days of the effective date
17 of this section. Three members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

18 120:5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
19 legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house
20 clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2014.

21 120:6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
