HOUSE BILL **283**

AN ACT establishing a study committee to review the hearings officer's report with regard to the New Hampshire Local Government Center and to study potential changes to RSA 5-B.

ANALYSIS

This bill establishes a committee to review the hearings officer's report with regard to the New Hampshire Local Government Center and to study potential changes to RSA 5-B.

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STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT establishing a study committee to review the hearings officer's report with regard to the New Hampshire Local Government Center and to study potential changes to RSA 5-B.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 208:1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to review the hearings officer's
2 report with regard to the New Hampshire Local Government Center and to study potential changes
3 to RSA 5-B.

4 208:2 Membership and Compensation.

5 I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

6 (a) Four members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house
7 of representatives.

8 (b) One member of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

9 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to
10 the duties of the committee.

11 208:3 Duties. The committee shall review the hearings officer's report with regard to the
12 New Hampshire Local Government Center and study potential changes to RSA 5-B, relative to
13 pooled risk management programs. The committee shall solicit information from any individual or
14 entity with experience or expertise relevant to the study.

15 208:4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson
16 from among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named
17 house member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 30 days of the effective date
18 of this section. Three members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

19 208:5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
20 legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house
21 clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2013.

22 208:6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
