*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

- 1            1 New Section; State Emblems; State Colors. Amend RSA 3 by inserting after section 26 the
- 2 following new section:
- 3            3:27 State Colors. The colors orange, red, and yellow are hereby designated as the official state
- 4 colors of New Hampshire.
- 5            2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
