Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 46:1 Service of Writs; Defendant County, Etc. Amend RSA 510:10 to read as follows: 2 510:10 Defendant County, Etc. Service of writs against counties may be made upon one of the 3 county commissioners and the treasurer for the county; against cities, upon the mayor or one of the aldermen and the city clerk, or in a city where the city manager is chief administrative officer 4 and the head of the administrative branch of the city government, upon the city manager 5 6 and the city clerk; against towns, upon one of the selectmen and the town clerk; against school 7 districts, upon one of the members of the school board and the clerk of the district; and against 8 village districts, upon one of the commissioners and the clerk of the district. 9 46:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2014.
