10	3 Duties. The committee shall study if and how to implement keno in the state.	
11	4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairper	son from
12	among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-nam	ed house
13	member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective da	te of this
14	section. Three members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.	
15	5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for	proposed
16	legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the senate president, the house of	elerk, the
17	senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2013.	
18	6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
