AN ACT relative to duties of town treasurers.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1	124:1 Town Treasurers; Duties. Amend RSA 41:29, I to read as follows:
2	I. The town treasurer shall have custody of all moneys belonging to the town, and shall pay
3	out the same only <i>as follows:</i>
4	(a) Upon orders of the selectmen in a public meeting or by a
5	noncontemporaneously signed manifest signed by a majority of the board; or,
6	(b) In the case of a conservation fund established pursuant to RSA 36-A:5, upon the
7	order of the conservation commission[5]; or
8	(c) In the case of a heritage [commission] fund established pursuant to RSA [674:44-a]
9	$674:44-d$ upon the order of the heritage commission[$_{7}$]; or
10	(d) In the case of fees held pursuant to RSA 673:16, II, upon the order of the local land
11	use board or its designated agent[,]; or
12	(e) In the case of a recreation revolving fund established pursuant to RSA 35-B:2, upon
13	the order of the recreation or park commission[5]; or
14	(f) In the case of fees deposited by the town clerk pursuant to RSA 41:25, upon the
15	invoice of the town clerk, or other board or body designated by the town to expend such a fund.
