AN ACT establishing New Hampshire anti-bullying day.

ANALYSIS

This bill requires the governor to issue an annual proclamation observing New Hampshire Anti-Bullying Day.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Thirteen

AN ACT establishing New Hampshire anti-bullying day.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Section; Powers of Governor and Council; New Hampshire Anti-Bullying Day. Amend
2 RSA 4 by inserting after section 13-r the following new section:

3 4:13-s New Hampshire Anti-Bullying Day. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation
4 calling for the proper observance of the second Wednesday of November as New Hampshire Anti-
5 Bullying Day and shall call on citizens, schools, and businesses of New Hampshire to observe the
6 week with appropriate ceremonies, activities, and educational events promoting New Hampshire
7 Anti-Bullying Day.

8 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
