STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Thirteen

AN ACT relative to recovering moneys from a neighboring state for mitigation of flooding.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 155:1 Recovery of Flood Moneys. The attorney general is hereby urged to expedite the pursuit of 2 the arrearages owed to New Hampshire by Massachusetts for mitigation of flooding as part of the 3 1953 and 1957 interstate compacts. The attorney general shall make quarterly reports to the 4 speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, and the governor commencing on 5 November 1, 2013 regarding its efforts to collect the moneys owed.
