Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

6 clarity, brevity, and the avoidance of technical language.

1 Voting Materials; General Responsibility. Amend RSA 656:1 to read as follows:

7 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
