AN ACT relative to hearings in the department of safety.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

125:1 Department of Safety; Bureau of Hearings. Amend RSA 21-P:13, II to read as follows: 1 $\mathbf{2}$ II. The bureau of hearings shall be responsible for holding all *adjudicative* hearings on 3 [licenses, permits, and registrations issued by] behalf of the commissioner of safety or any division of the department [pursuant to title XXI, RSA 106-F, and RSA 158]. The bureau of hearings 4 $\mathbf{5}$ shall have authority to take disciplinary action in the name of such division against any holder of [such] a license, permit, or registration issued by such division in accordance with law. [Unless 6 7otherwise provided by law, all rehearings and appeals shall be held in accordance with RSA 541.] Unless otherwise provided by law, all appeals of a decision of the 8 II-a. 9 commissioner of safety or the bureau of hearings shall be pursuant to RSA 541. 125:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect January 1, 2014. 10
