SENATE BILL **14**

AN ACT relative to the rulemaking authority of and administrative fine authority for the department of resources and economic development.

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill:

I. Repeals the prospective repeal of the authority of the department of resources and economic development to adopt rules on assessing administrative fines.

II. Increases the percentage of administrative fines collected in accordance with the schedule of administrative fines of the department of resources and economic development that municipalities may retain.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Thirteen

AN ACT relative to the rulemaking authority of and administrative fine authority for the department of resources and economic development.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 166:1 Repeal. 2010, 230:10-12, relative to repealing administrative fines; and rulemaking
2 authority by the department of resources and economic development, are repealed.

3 166:2 Department of Resources and Economic Development; Police Powers. Amend RSA 12-A:1-
4 d, II to read as follows:

5 II. By written agreement executed by the commissioner of the department of resources and
6 economic development, any authorized municipal official may utilize the summons procedures under
7 RSA 31:39-d to cite individuals for violations of state park administrative rules or forests and lands
8 administrative rules, or both. Authorized municipalities acting under this paragraph shall retain
9 ~~[50]~~ **100** percent of any fine collected in accordance with the schedule of administrative fines of the
10 department of resources and economic development.

11 166:3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect June 27, 2013.
